1. ALWAYS buy new fabric.
2. NEVER bleed on the quilt!!
3. Measure often. Cut once.
4. Dinner can wait until you are "at a good stopping point."  
4a. There are no "good stopping points."
5. There's no such thing as too many quilts-in-progress.
6. It's not a mistake... it's a happy accident!

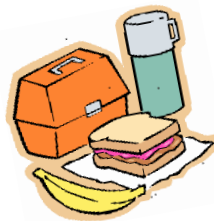
