However, as a chapter, we are planning for the reopening by preparing fabric into kits to be ready to cut or be checked out to sew. We were given 43 yards of kid's prints in May to be used for these kits. Thanks to the Chunking Team who met with me and prepared 70 kits.

During the month of June, many peas, beans squash, zucchini and peppers were harvested. Still waiting on okra and tomatoes. Oh, the butter peas turned out to be string beans.

I hope that you are safe and well and that we can meet and share stories soon. Know that the amount of patients in our hospital is small and the amount of quilts ready to be given out is large. I have heard from several of you saying that you have many quilts made and are ready to turn in. Thanks for your work! We'll certainly need them when the weather cools again in the Fall. Hold on to them if you can, and I'll get them as we meet again. We're shooting for resuming our workshops in September.

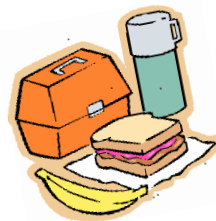
